1. Check yellow sheet (OPNAV 3760-2) and weapon system status.

2. External power-OFF.




GENERAL CHECKS

THE FOLLOWING GENERAL CHECKS SHOULD BE PERFORMED THROUGH-OUT THE EXTERIOR INSPECTION: CRACKS, DISTORTIONS, LOOSE FASTENESS AND FITTINGS, COYES REMOVED SHOULD BE SECURED, FUEL OIL AND HYDRAULIC LEAKS, ACCESS DOORS AND PANELS SECURELY FASTENED.

NOTE

The exterior inspection begins at the nose of the aircraft and progresses in a counter-clockwise direction around the aircraft. Hems that are on both sides of the aircraft are called out as a repeated letter index, i.e. "C".
